| Child Abuse | 3 | Child Maltreatment: Child Abuse and Neglect | Child maltreatment represents a serious public health concern that imposes a range of deleterious consequences for victims' mental and physical health across the lifespan. Approximately 3.5 million U.S. children were the subject of a child maltreatment investigation in 2018 and approximately 678,000 of those case investigations were founded (i.e., supported) for maltreatment. These rates represent a steady incline from past years, indicating a failure of systems and providers to both address and prevent this issue (U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, Administration for Children and Families, Administration on Children, Youth and Families, Children's Bureau, 2020). Mental health, human services, and healthcare providers are the frontline forces for preventing, recognizing, and treating child maltreatment. It is therefore critical that service providers are able to define, identify, assess, and treat child abuse and neglect, with the ultimate aim of preventing such abuses and protecting youth. The course will define child maltreatment according to federal, state civil and state criminal definitions. Providers will learn other empirical and academic definitions of child maltreatment, including the differences among these terms (e.g., corporal punishment versus abuse). The learning material addresses culture, context, and environment in addition to other special considerations.
